Regarding Old Business, Baer reported no change to McDonald Creek Trunk South Branch (Machesney Park). Regarding West State Street Sanitary Sewer Improvements (City of Rockford), District staff had previously confirmed that IDOT will make allowances for the District's Contractor to make improvements to the sanitary sewer system this spring, in conjunction with the IDOT roadway project. Depending on the spring schedule and IDOT project status, staff was tentatively planning for a March 2021 award. However, staff has been notified by IDOT that there has been further delay with property acquisition, and the project letting would need to be delayed again. Staff will continue to coordinate this project schedule with IDOT and the City of Rockford and determine if there is still need for this agreement as the construction schedule becomes more apparent.

Calvin presented the Information Technology Monthly Report as of March, 2021, highlighting successes such as completing installation of new software to filter for e-mail phishing attacks, near completion of programming changes to STREAMS to accommodate addition of phosphorous testing, and strong performance in addressing IT Help Desk tickets, with zero pending tickets from the month of February.

Scott-Valdez provided an update regarding Human Resources Department initiatives and achievements for the previous month and future plans, including staffing and employee relations. Highlights include Teamster contract negotiations, ERP (electronic finance, HR, billing and permitting system) RFP, COVID-19 planning, Web RFP and branding and Budget.

Scott-Valdez also presented an informational-only update on the District Hardship Program, which began March 1, 2021.

Mittel presented the Finance Management Report, advising that, for the period ending February 28, 2021, User Fee Revenue is 3.71% below budget YTD, Total Revenue is 4.14% under budget YTD and O&M Departmental Expenses are 6.44% under budget YTD. Operating Income reflects a gain of \$5,386,250, and the Statement of Cash Flow reflects an increase of \$1,845,951 for the fiscal year. The General Fund ended the month at \$37.75M.
