In particular, Hanson called to the Board's attention a memo from Scott-Valdez regarding 2020 Health & Voluntary Benefit Renewal Rates. 2020 rates will reflect a 4.7% decrease in health insurance and a 5% increase in dental insurance (offset by an adjustment of the annual benefit maximum from \$1500/person to \$2000/person). The Vision insurance rate is still being negotiated and will be presented prior to the next Board Meeting.

McFall reported that the first Watershed Group Meeting took place this past week, marking that this piece of permit compliance is now underway. Cassaro then expressed his gratitude to the Board for approving purchase requests on several components in need of upgrade in order to provide the District's high-level of service. Cassaro then presented Plant Operation's monthly "snapshot."

Markgraf provided status of Collection Systems activity regarding sewer main line cleaning, televising crews, pipe replacement, manhole ticket backlog breakdown and manhole restoration for the month of September, 2019.

Black reported that, as of the end of September, 2019, total revenue is 7.2% below budget YTD, O&M expenses are 0.7% over budget YTD; operating income reflects \$3.154M, and the Statement of Cash Flows shows an increase of \$6.6M. The General Fund ended the month at \$37.5M.

Black initiated a discussion regarding passage of Ordinance No. 19/20-B-01, RRWRD Public Benefit Chlorination and Corporate Tax Levy, an Ordinance for the levy and assessment of a tax for the purpose of paying (1) that portion of the several amounts heretofore assessed against the District for the public benefit as well as paying any such amounts as may be assessed hereafter for public benefit under and in pursuance of any ordinance that may be adopted hereafter by the Board of Trustees; (2) payments for chlorination, de-chlorination and additional treatment required to meet water quality standards; and (3) the corporate purposes of the RRWRD located in the County of Winnebago, State of Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2020 and ending April 30, 2021. Black advised that the Ordinance must be passed and filed no later than December 23, 2019. As such, the Board decided to take additional time for consideration and will vote on it at the November 18, 2019, Board Meeting.

Black provided a review of the District's financial results for FY2019, focusing primarily on the General Operations and Public Benefit Funds, and the increase in District cash and cash equivalents from the prior year.
