Hanson announced the update of District management job titles. Hanley provided a redlined version of the RRWRD By-Laws highlighting areas that need to be updated to reflect the new title of the Executive Director. Hanley will present a Resolution for Board approval at the October meeting. (No vote until October in order to allow 30-days prior notice.)

Scott-Valdez advised that the re-branding initiative is now underway. Interviews are taking place and are expected to be completed within the week, at which point a timeline will be established for next steps. Scott-Valdez anticipates end of first quarter 2020 for completion of the re-branding.

Hanson advised he met with Senator Dave Syverson, who advised that the State of Illinois is considering dedicating \$3B toward infrastructure for sanitation/fresh water. Syverson inquired about potential projects which may benefit from this allowance, to which Hanson advised CIP No. 2022 for primary filtration.

Scott-Valdez provided a summary of HR Department initiatives, achievements as of September 1, 2019, and future plans, including employment, system improvements, organizational development, benefits and branding.

Scott-Valdez then presented Resolution 19/20-04, appointing the RRWRD IMRF Authorized Agent. As Director of Human Resources, Scott-Valdez would be the District's Authorized Agent. Pollack moved to approve, seconded by Jones; motion passed upon roll call as follows:

McFall advised that recent heavy rains resulted in an unprecedented five-foot rise of the Rock River, resulting in an overflow excursion (which was reported to the State of Illinois).

Cassaro presented the Plant Operation's monthly "snapshot," indicating that the month of August was the first in some time that the District has been at or under daily average flow. Cassaro then went over current trend reports for the month of August.

Reader provided status of activity regarding sewer main line cleaning, televising crews, pipe replacement, manhole ticket backlog breakdown and manhole restoration for the month of August, 2019.

Black reported that, as of the end of August, 2019, total revenue is 5.3% below budget YTD, O&M expenses are 2.6% over budget YTD (primarily due to seasonal expenses); income reflects \$2.1M, and the Statement of Cash Flows shows an increase of \$3.9M. The General Fund ended the month at \$34.8M.

Black provided a summary of results from the recent refunding of 2010 Series Bonds. Total savings are approximately \$595k (11.4% principle). Black also advised that the District maintained an Aa2 credit rating from Moody's Investors Service.
