Bid Bond: N

Y next to an item means it is required. N next to an item means it is not required. The wording is generally included in the bid document with the cover page used to indicate if it is required for the specific bid.

### **AD1-4 Questions & Answers**

**Question 1:** Is there a scheduled completion date, and what is the date?

**Answer 1:** Yes, March 31, 2023

- Question 2: Paragraph 2.4 indicates a performance and payment bond is required. This is not typical for a small direct procurement bid? Would you consider removing this requirement?
- **Answer 2:** No, we will not waive the performance and payment bond. It is required under the Public Construction Bond Act (30 ILCS 550)
- Question 3: Cover states prevailing wage is not required; 2.9 B cites the prevailing wage Act? Not sure manufactures fall under this requirement?
- **Answer 3:** The Prevailing Wage Act does not apply in this instance.
- Question 4: The general specifications indicate that a bid bond of 10% is required in paragraph 2.3 Bid Security. Please confirm if required or not required
- **Answer 4:** A bid security is not required.
