ORDINANCE NO. 24 25 R 06

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ALL RATES, FEES, CHARGES, PENALTIES, BOND REQUIREMENTS, PERMITS AND ADDITIONAL CHARGES FOR THE FOUR RIVERS SANITATION AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Four Rivers Sanitation Authority (Authority) has enacted a Code of Ordinances, which Code provides for the establishment of rates, fees, charges, bond requirements, permits and additional charges, and

charges, reviewed the rates, fees, Board of Trustees has WHEREAS. the permits and additional charges set forth in the Code of Ordinances, Authority policy, and other sources, requirements, permits to incorporate all such rates, fees, charges, bond and has determined additional charges into one document;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Four Rivers Sanitation Authority, State of Illinois that bills, invoices, statements and notices issued by the Authority shall be charged as follows:

ARTICLE I

Inspection fees for inspections conducted by Authority personnel during overtime hours shall be one and one-half (1½) times the Charge-out Rate multiplied by the number of overtime hours worked, computed in increments of one-tenth hour. The overtime rate shall be charged for any hours worked outside of the sewer construction inspection hours of 6:30 A.M. to 2:30 P.M., Monday through Friday, or service connection inspection hours of 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., Monday through Friday, as applicable, excepting Authority observed holidays which shall be charged at the holiday rate. Inspection fees for both sewer construction and service connection inspections conducted by Authority personnel during hours worked on days observed by the Authority as holidays shall be two and one-half (2 1/2) times the Charge-out Rate multiplied by the number of holiday hours worked, computed in increments of one-tenth hour.
