

**Addendum No. 1**

This Addendum Number 1, dated April 17, 2026, for the above-referenced project, supersedes all contrary and conflicting information in the specifications and contract documents, which are hereby supplemented or revised as follows:

**BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND CONTRACT FORMS ADDITIONS**

**Section I Bidding Requirements, Article 3 Detailed Specifications**

- Add the following paragraphs to the end of *Section 21 – Sanitary Sewer Main Line Repair, 21.1 General*:

Testing Requirements

Low pressure air testing of the sanitary sewer main line repair will not be required.

All sanitary sewer main line repairs shall be inspected by FRSA via internal television inspection for final acceptance. Contractor shall coordinate televising with the FRSA inspector. Televising shall be completed prior to removal of bypass pumping and installation of grouted riprap, but after final installation, backfilling and compaction have been completed.

Any defects identified by FRSA which may affect the maintenance, integrity, or strength of the pipe, including offsets at the pipe transition or sags in the pipe, in the opinion of FRSA, shall be repaired or replaced by the Contractor at the Contractor's sole expense.

The Contractor shall provide FRSA a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours advance notice when requesting that a sewer segment be televised.

**Meeting Notes In Red**

I. Introduction

- A. See attached sign-in sheet for attendance.
- B. The Creek Crossing Protection – Alpine Park project consists of the repair and reroute of encased, undermined sanitary sewer crossing Keith Creek in Alpine Park. Work includes removal and replacement of encased sanitary sewer, installation of new sanitary sewer, armoring of encased sanitary sewer with grouted riprap, removal and replacement of storm sewer, tree removal and replacement in Aldeen Park, and all other appurtenances indicated on the plans and in the specifications.
- C. Important Dates
  - i. Last day to send questions will be Wednesday, April 15, 2026.
  - ii. Last day for an addenda to be issued will be Friday, August 17, 2026.
  - iii. Bids are due Monday, April 20, 2026, at 2:00 PM.
  - iv. Project anticipated to be awarded at the FRSA Board Meeting currently scheduled for April 27, 2026.
  - v. Project completion date of September 30, 2026.

II. Permits and Approvals

- A. Contractor is required to comply with all requirements of permits required to construct this project.
- B. The total disturbed area for this project is estimated to be 0.75 acres therefore no National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit is required.
- C. FRSA will acquire the IEPA Sanitary Sewer Permit.
- D. City of Rockford approved plans March 17, 2026.
- E. EcoCAT clearance granted March 19, 2026.
- F. IHPA clearance submitted April 1, 2026.
- G. FRSA is currently working with Rockford Park District on acquiring easements. FRSA has existing easements allowing the Base Bid repair work, however, the Alternate Bid sanitary sewer reroute will require a permanent utility easement. Easements are anticipated to be approved by the Rockford Park District at their May Board meeting.

III. Construction

- A. Base Bid Work (Alpine Park Only)
  - i. Reroute existing 24-inch storm sewer.
  - ii. Remove, replace, and encase existing encased 12-inch sanitary sewer.
  - iii. Extend existing encasement on existing 21-inch sanitary sewer.

- iv. Riprap and grout existing creek bed and slopes.
  - 1. 22-inches of RR5 on 8-inches of RR1 or RR2
  - 2. Top 4-inches of riprap should remain exposed
  - 3. Grout placement technique shall be demonstrated at the start of construction
- B. Alternate Bid A Work (Alpine and Aldeen Park)
  - i. Clear existing trees indicated on plans.
  - ii. Furnish and plant replacement trees at Aldeen Park.
    - 1. Equal mixture of White Oak, Bur Oak, and Chinkapin
    - 2. Rockford Park District will maintain trees after planting
  - iii. Install new 8-inch sanitary sewer.
  - iv. Fill and abandon existing 8-inch sanitary sewer.

A. Testing requirements for the sanitary sewer repairs will be clarified in an addendum.
